Due to other scheduled events, groups may arrive no earlier than 10 minutes prior to their party start time.

What to Expect:

Prairie Package

- **A.** Birthday Coordinator: Present the day of the event. Available to answer questions. It is up to the party host to serve food and/or facilitate activities.
- **B.** Safety Rules: A lifeguard will review pool rules before anyone may enter the water. Every swimmer must wear a swimmer's wrist band.
- **C.** Deep Water Swim Test: Following the safety speech, anyone wishing to access deep water activities will take a swim test with a lifeguard.
- **D.** Pizza will be delivered at the beginning of the party.
- **E.** Groups are responsible for clean-up within their reservation time. All trash and table covers must go in the trash can.

Ohio Package

- **A.** Birthday Coordinator: Present the day of the event. Available to answer questions. It is up to the party host to serve food and/or facilitate activities.
- **B.** Safety Rules: A lifeguard will review pool rules before anyone may enter the water. Every swimmer must wear a swimmer's wrist band.
- **C.** Deep Water Swim Test: Following the safety speech, anyone wishing to access deep water activities will take a swim test with a lifeguard.
- **D.** Groups are responsible for clean-up within their reservation time. All trash and table covers must go in the trash can.

What Flotation Devices are Permitted?

Water wings, noodles, suits with built-in flotation, baby seat floaters and Coast Guard approved life jackets. We do not permit rafts, inner tubes or Mermaid Tails.

Party Ratios:

- 1. Children ages 6-9 must be accompanied by an adult on the pool deck area at all times.
- One adult must be present for every 5 children ages 6-9.
- 2. Children ages 5 and younger must be accompanied in the water and be within arm's reach of an adult.
- One adult must be present for every two children 5 years old and younger.
- *Anyone using a flotation device must be accompanied by an adult in the water.

Cancellation:

Upon written cancellation of a party at least 2 weeks prior to the event, Prairie Township will refund the rental fees collected, less a \$5 administrative fee.

Refunds are not given for inclement weather.

Recommended Party Schedule

General Pool Rules

- 1. All users must wear appropriate swim wear (Lycra, spandex or nylon).
- 2. No street clothes can be worn in the water. Cut-offs, gym shorts, bras, underwear, thongs are prohibited.
- 3. All users must shower before entering the pool.
- 4. Running, pushing, spitting or horseplay is not prohibited.
- 5. Users with open wounds or infectious diseases are not allowed in the pool.
- 6. Non-swimmers of any age are not permitted in the deep end.
- 7. All youth, ages 15 and under, are required to take a swim test if they wish to swim in the deep end. The swim test will require jumping into the deep end, resurfacing at the top of the water and swimming the entire length of the pool.
- 8. Safety breaks are called 15 minutes before each hour. Youth ages 3-17 must exit the water.
- 9. Swim diapers are required for children who are not toilet trained. "Swimmies" are available for purchase at the front desk. Regular diapers are prohibited in the pool.
- 10. No food or drink, with the exception of water, is permitted in the pool area.





Splash Pad Rules

- 1. Children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult (18+).
- 2. Swim suits and/or appropriate attire must be worn at all times.
- 3. Food and/or beverages, except water, are not permitted.
- 4. No glass containers or otherwise breakable objects are allowed.
- 5. Do not climb, hang, swing, or pull on any of the equipment.
- 6. Swim diapers are required for children who are not toilet trained.

Climbing Wall Rules

- 1. One person at a time.
- 2. Assistance of any kind will not be permitted.
- 3. Flotation devices or life jackets will not be permitted.
- 4. No loose fitting T-shirts or any other clothing will be permitted.
- 5. Passing a swim test is required to use the climbing wall for ages 15 and younger.
